**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 130 ORDINANCE 2012-001
VOTING DISTRICTS**

THE TOWN OF MONTVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

There shall be five (5) voting districts in the Town of Montville. This ordinance shall amend or repeal all previous ordinances of the Town of Montville with regard to voting districts.

The voting districts shall be known as follows: First District, Second District, Third District, Fourth District, and Fifth District. These voting districts are shown on the Town Voting District Map of February 16th, 2022 which is hereby incorporated into this Section by reference and is available in the Office of the Town Clerk and the land use office.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of its adoption.
