I. Chairman's Report:

- Barbara is the new President of CYSA – 2 year term

- Youth Action Council (YAC) is restarting – great group of kids from the ASP signed up. They will have weekly meetings to discuss community service projects (penny drive, wake-a-thon, and Trick or Trunk are some of the upcoming events they will be working on).
- Intern from CCSU, Barb O'Donnell, has been here and will stay until June. She needs 400 hours of social work internship. We are so happy to have her here after school.
- Barbara had a discussion with the Mayor about moving from current address to Fair Oaks. A walk through will be planned soon to discuss the needs of the Youth Center. All Board members will be invited to attend.

III. Old Business

- Summer Center – 8 weeks, 30 kids – fantastic summer. Cops and kids came together for some fun on Wednesday field trips. The experience was fantastic for both the kids and the cops. Lt. Bunnell praised both the Youth Center and the cops for making it happen.
- JRB is going well. The families serviced are very happy with the process. Seven new JRB cases have been started this past year.
- Concert 2012 – Thank you to Councilman Caron for his efforts in getting the Tribe to donate the concert tickets. About \$8,000 was raised and will be split between the Youth Center and Senior/Social Services.

- ASP Credentialing – looking into but still a lot of work to come. Teachers are needed to help with math and science – additional pieces to follow
- Family Day 2012 was held here in the parking area – families enjoyed popcorn, cotton candy, old fashion games and fun was had by all. This event had a great turnout, especially by the new ASP families.

IV. Good and Welfare

- Community booklet has been distributed, and the Youth Center has extra copies if needed.
- Pfizer continues to donate about \$200.00 a month.
- YAC will be constructing a wishing well for gift card donations.
