## Special Meeting Minutes April 19, 2019, 9:00 AM Montville Conservation Center

- Call to Order
  - The Special Meeting of the Montville Conservation Commission was called to order at 9:03 AM
- Roll Call
  - Commissioners Emilyta, Chase, DiNoto, and LeClair were present.
- Walk the Montville Conservation Center trails, perform simple maintenance as necessary, assess trail conditions, etc.
  - Commissioners were joined by a local Eagle Scout, his family, and the President of the Montville Rotary Club to identify joint projects.
  - Commissioners assessed the condition of the parking area and the two signs at the site, one sign located along Chesterfield Rd., and the other at the back of the parking lot.
  - Boy Scout, Devin Steiseo will work with Councilman Tom McNally, Commissioner LeClair, and the Montville Public Works Department to orchestrate his Eagle Scout project. Steiseo will resurface the parking lot with left-over secondary millings provided by the Public Works Department.
  - The Montville Rotary Club would like to improve the sign at the back of the parking lot to make it a welcome center. The Conservation Commission will work with the Club to first update the map to reflect the trails at the site.
  - Commissioners walked the Montville Conservation Center trails assessing their condition and performing simple maintenance as necessary.
